The regular monthly meeting of the North Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Supervisor Dan Dickey with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present at the meeting were Supervisors Bob Waddingham and Eloise Settlemyre, and Secretary/Treasurer Donna Kean.

Public Comment Period – Rosanne Staab questioned Bob Waddingham on residency requirements for people sitting on boards, and reported blight on the Chuck Britton and the former Joe Mully properties.

Tony Caveeck spoke regarding an article he read concerning township residents not running or wishing to do anything and coming to meetings and complaining. He also voiced his concerns regarding the time of the township meeting.

Committee Reports:

- Building Code – Mike Klink submitted and read his report.
- Code Enforcement – None
- Parks & Recreation – George Nowack gave his report and Eloise Settlemyre gave an update.
- Crime Watch – Bob Troutman gave a report.
- Fire Dept. – Report was submitted.
- Roadmaster – Dan submitted and gave his report.

The minutes from the February 13, 2018 regular meeting were presented for approval. Eloise Settlemyre made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, Bob Waddingham seconded the motion. Voted for Bob, Dan, and Eloise.

The monthly invoices & payroll for the period of 2/14/2018 to 3/13/2018 were presented for approval. Eloise Settlemyre made a motion to approve the invoices as presented and to pay the bills, Bob Waddingham seconded the motion. Voted for Bob, Dan, and Eloise.

Secretary Report – Donna Kean reported of the following items:

- Liquid Fuels payment of \$189,300.03
- Cadman Fire Extinguisher Service submitted a price sheet. Their pricing is substantially lower than Cintas, so she will be changing companies.

Old Business – Dan Dickey reported that the grader has been sent to Five Star for repairs. The updated estimate is \$1,000.00 more than the original estimate from last Spring. Dan made a motion to approve the additional cost of \$1,000.00 for repair of the grader, Eloise Settlemyre seconded the motion. Voted for Bob, Dan, and Eloise.


New Business – Donna Kean submitted some information on a new garbage collection company (Raccoon Refuse) that is willing to service the residents of the township.

The Township received a bid from Glenn Robison of \$250.00 for two pieces of scrap equipment; one trailer with cracked water tank and one back blade. Dan Dickey made a motion to approve the bid of \$250.00 for scrap equipment from Glen Robison, Eloise Settlemyre seconded the motion. Voted for Bob, Dan, and Eloise.

Supervisor Report – Bob Waddingham reported on the drainage work that was done on Pine Road.

Public Comment on Agenda Items – Rose Staab reported that there is a culvert on Bullis Road that keeps washing out. She was informed that it is scheduled to be repaired.
