

The regular monthly meeting of the North Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Supervisor Dan Dickey with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present at the meeting were Supervisors Eloise Settlemyre, and Roseanne Staab, and Secretary/Treasurer Donna Kean.

Public Comment Period – Tony Caveeck questioned why there were no treasurers reports lately.

Tom Fedorka asked about the squatters on Pilgrim Lane and about the RV trailer that is still there.

Valerie O'Brien stated if they have an RV on the property then they should be required to have a permit.

Mary Catherine Crom asked about the work to be done to the ditch on Crom Road.

Tom Tormabene asked about the people camping on Montgomery & Reigleman and stated that he is not happy with people being able to put campers on their property.

Linda Wolf questioned why the Township is telling people they can put campers in Colonial Estates #4.

Lynn Kissling asked how long the people on 1<sup>st</sup> Street have to hook up to the new sewer lines, and asked if people can put up tents on their property.

Arlene Seng stated that the state of PA says you can't tent on your property, unless you have a home with sewage.

Chris Feezle commented on issues with RV's on properties in the Township.

#### Committee Reports:

- Parks & Recreation – Valerie O'Brien gave an update. Eloise Settlemyre made a motion to appoint Linda Wolfe to the Parks and Recreation Board. Roseanne Staab seconded the motion. Voted for, Dan, Roseanne, and Eloise.

- Fire Dept. – Mike White submitted a report and gave an update.

The minutes from the May 9, 2023 regular meeting were presented for approval. Eloise Settlemyre made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Roseanne Staab seconded the motion. Voted for, Dan, Roseanne, and Eloise.

The monthly invoices for the period of 5/10/2023 to 6/13/2023 were presented for approval. Eloise Settlemyre made a motion to approve the invoices as presented and to pay the bills. Dan Dickey seconded the motion. Voted for, Dan, Roseanne, and Eloise.

The monthly payroll for the period of 5/10/2023 to 6/13/2023 was presented for approval. Roseanne Staab made a motion to approve the payroll as presented. Eloise Settlemyre seconded the motion. Voted for, Dan, Roseanne, and Eloise.

Secretary Report – Donna Kean thanked Chris from Countryside Restaurant for donating lunch for the Township employees for Clean-up day.

Old Business – In regards to the Shooting Ordinance, the Supervisors are not ready to move forward with it. They have learned from the Solicitor that in a recent court hearing, in regards to the regulation of firearms, the General Assembly has assumed sole regulatory power. The Solicitor is concerned that if we pass a “Firearms Ordinance” we may open ourselves up to a long legal battle.

New Business – Dan Dickey made a motion to retroactively hire John Meyers (5/15/23) and Bradley Harthan (5/22/23) as full-time employees at \$18.50/hr, and Patrick Murphy (6/3/23) as a part-time, as needed, at \$17.00/hr. Eloise Settlemyre seconded the motion. Voted for, Dan, Roseanne, and Eloise.


Supervisors Report – Roseanne Staab voiced her concerns with the County Assessment office and their practice of driving around Townships to find new buildings to assess. She also commented on the crisis with Fire Departments and their need for more volunteers.

Eloise Settlemyre commented that she cannot believe that the school taxes are going up again. She also wanted to thank everyone for coming to clean-up day.

Public Comment on Agenda Items – Chris Feezle voiced his concern about damage being done to North Lake Road from all the construction trucks going in and out of Tuttle Campground

Chris Bugielski questioned speed limits on the roads.
