

The regular monthly meeting of the North Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Supervisor Dan Dickey with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present at the meeting were Supervisors Eloise Settlemyre, and Roseanne Staab, and Secretary/Treasurer Donna Kean.

Public Comment Period – Tony Caveeck complained that the roadside has not been mowed and commented on a trailer that is on Pine Road.

Arleen Starr questioned how the Code Enforcement officer is paid and how many hours he works.

Valerie O'Brien questioned payment to previous Code Enforcement Officers.

Chuck O'Brien questioned the use of storage containers in the Township.

Laurie Condrin voiced concerns with being able to use golf carts in the Township.

Mary Catherine Crom asked for an update on the Crom Road project.

Linn Kissling questioned what the letter that is being sent out by the Code Enforcement Officer says.

Old Business – Dan Dickey gave an update on the Crom Road project.

Supervisors gave an update on ATV's and Golf Carts on Township roads and presented information from the Police Department.

New Business – Roseanne Staab questioned having the Township replace the Fire Department sirens. After speaking with Mike White from the fire department, it was decided not to repair the sirens. Now a days the alert systems with cell phones are much better, and makes the sirens somewhat obsolete. He suggested people purchase at home weather radios instead.

Roseanne Staab discussed Township signage and the need for more stop signs. Dan reported that the road crew is already working on a plan to put up more stop signs next year.

Roseanne Staab discussed a tax increase to help the Fire Department. Dan Dickey and Eloise Settlemyre gave their opinion and stated they are not in favor of raising taxes at this point.

The Supervisors decided not to have a township wide Trick or Treat night and instead promote the Halloween Party at the Community Center and Fire Department.

Supervisors Report – Eloise Settlemyre gave an update on Tuttle Campground, and reported on PSATS trying to increase the wage rate for the Township auditors. She also commented on a Fog Seal that Sadsbury Township has used on Greiser Road that turned out really nice and is supposed to extend the life of the sealcoat.

Dan Dickey gave an update on the signs requested for directing people to Tuttle Campground.

Public Comment on Agenda Items – Valerie O'Brien asked when the budget meeting is scheduled for.

Tony Caveeck asked if the Township is required to clean out culverts.

With no further business being brought before the Board of Supervisors at this time, Dan Dickey adjourned the meeting at 11:41 AM.
