

The regular monthly meeting of the North Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Supervisor Dan Dickey with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present at the meeting were Supervisors Eloise Settlemyre, and Roseanne Staab, and Secretary/Treasurer Donna Kean.

Public Comment Period – Tony Caveeck complained of planning work done on his road.

Tom Fedorka who lives on Delaware Lane complained of squatters on Penn Lane.

Chuck Berie complained of two trailers on Pilgrim Lane.

Chris Bugielski complained about the same two trailers on Pilgrim Lane.

Debbie Flick asked if there were plans for dust control for the dirt roads. She has information from Penn State on how to maintain dirt roads.

Peggy Ferchak asked what happens after letters are sent out from the Code Enforcement Officer. What is the process?

Linda McAnalley said she knows there are issues with the roads but the guys working are doing a great job.

Mary Catherine Crom questioned what is going on with the drainage issues on Crom Road.

Bernie Ferchak asked for an update on the Princess Lane issue.


Public Comment on Agenda Items – Valerie O’Brien questioned if a section of Linn Road would be fixed.
