

The regular monthly meeting of the North Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Supervisor Dan Dickey with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present at the meeting were Supervisors Eloise Settlemyre and Roseanne Staab, and Secretary/Treasurer Donna Kean.

Public Comment Period – Laurie Condrin spoke about laws regarding riding golf carts on the roads.

Cindy Wightman reported that they are already handing out license plates for golf carts.

Shari Hudak spoke regarding the licensing of golf carts in PA and Ohio.

Valerie O'Brien discussed the list she turned in of 17 properties with RV's on them that do not have a permit.

Bob Goff responded to Valerie regarding the RV's.

Roseanne Staab discussed the use of RV's on the property while building a house.

Michael Conway spoke regarding the District Justice and the fines included in the ordinances.

Valerie O'Brien stated that Bob Goff does a great job and asked if he could get help.

Lucy Burke asked for an update on the review of the zoning ordinance.

Arlene Seng asked who got the money from the RV permits, and spoke regarding RV's in other Townships.
