

The regular monthly meeting of the North Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Supervisor Dan Dickey with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present at the meeting were Supervisors Eloise Settlemyre and Roseanne Staab, Solicitor Brett Steadman, and Secretary/Treasurer Donna Kean.

Public Comment Period – Tony Caveeck spoke regarding Bob Goff and his resignation.

Valerie O'Brien asked about the letter she gave the Township regarding RV's and wanted an update on who obtained an RV permit.

Laurie Condrin responded to a comment made regarding full-time/part-time residents.

Lucy Burke asked for an update on the new zoning ordinance and the process that needs followed.

Bob Thompson asked if Supervisors run the Township or does Valerie O'Brien. He is tired of listening to her complain.

Valerie O'Brien responded that she is a concerned resident and the Supervisors have not done much of anything in the last four years.

Bob Lindenfelser thanked the road crew for putting up an arrow sign on a dangerous curve on South Lake Road.

Lucy Burke asked if pop-up advertising signs are allowed.

Mike Petronio asked if signs are permitted on private property.

Roseanne Staab also stated that she would like to have open dialogue regarding chickens when redoing the zoning ordinance.

The issue with Port-a-pots was discussed; when they are allowed and when it is a violation.


Supervisors Report – Eloise Settlemyre spoke regarding the Police Commission meeting coming up. The Township has a proposal for them to continue service and hopes the Commission will accept it. Eloise also stated that she had spoken with Bob Goff and thought everything was fine. She is upset that he said he is resigning.

Public Comment on Agenda Items – Laurie Condrin reported that there is a tree on the wires on Leach Road. She also stated she is not happy with the work on her road (Kenny Dr.) and wanted to know when any work will be done on it. She also stated there is an RV on Kenny Dr. with no RV permit.

Valerie O'Brien asked if there was a leash law in the Township and if an RV permit is required while building.

Richard Barabas spoke regarding the trespassing issue with Bob Goff and the issue of the decision of the District Magistrate regarding the RV porch on Fries Rd.
